WHAT IS ROTARACT???

- Rotaract originally began as a Rotary International youth program in 1968 and has grown into a major Rotary-sponsored organization of over 10,904 clubs spread around the world and 250792 members in 184 countries.
- It is a service, leadership and community service organization for young men and women between the ages 16–30. Rotaract focuses on the development of young adults as leaders in their communities and workplaces.
- "Rotaract" stands for "Rotary in Action".
- Most Rotaract activities take place at the club level. Rotaract clubs hold formal meetings, usually every two weeks, which feature speakers, special outings, social activities, discussions or visits to other clubs. Club members get together on designated days for service project work, social events, or professional/leadership development workshops.
- The purpose of Rotaract is to provide an opportunity for young men and women to enhance the knowledge and skills that will assist them in personal development, to address the physical and social needs of their communities, and to promote better relations between all people worldwide through a framework of friendship and service.
- To be eligible for membership, prospective members must be 16–30 years of age, show that they are committed to Rotaract, and show that they are of good standing in the community. After being approved by the club, prospective members are inducted to become members, also known as 'Rotaractors'.

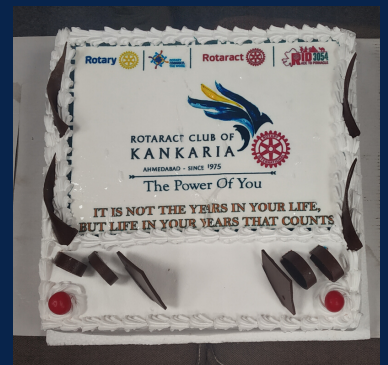
